- 1) A career position **directly related** to their geographical knowledge and skills.
- A first degree in geography is an entry point to many careers, for example: town and transport planning, chartered surveying, land and water management, sustainability, environmental consultancy, development, tourism, conservation, demography, housing and social welfare
- At some point these careers will require further qualifications leading for example to chartered status, but many will offer the opportunity to do these qualifications whilst working.

- The majority of geographers chose careers which make use of their transferable skills. Graduates from other disciplines will also enter these areas. These include information technology, administration and management, the financial sector, marketing, research, and industry and manufacturing
